

## Form I-4B | First Notice of inquiry from Registrar concerning carrying on business

## 1. General statement

Section 431(a) of the Myanmar Companies Law 2017 states:

“Where the Registrar has reasonable cause to believe that a company is not carrying on business, the Registrar shall send to the company by post, or by electronic or other means, a notice inquiring whether the company is carrying on business.”

Section 431(b) of the Myanmar Companies Law 2017 then states:

“If the Registrar does not within 28 days of sending the notice receive any answer thereto, the Registrar shall within 60 days after the expiration of the initial period send to the company by any means referred to in subsection (a) **Error! Reference source not found.**, a further notice referring to the first notice, and stating that no answer thereto has been received and that, if an answer is not received to the further notice within 28 days from the date thereof, a notice will be published in the Gazette with a view to striking the name of the company off the register.”

## 2. Notice from Registrar

Pursuant to section 431(a) of the Myanmar Companies Law 2017, the Registrar hereby provides this Notice of inquiry to the company regarding whether the company is carrying on business.

The company must respond to this Notice (by completing Form 1-4A) within 28 days from the date of this Notice.
